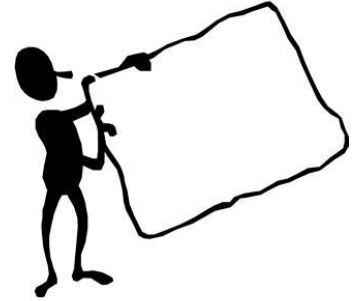


Ancient Middle East Resident Expert Project
